Program Overview



Who Can Participate

Critical Access Hospitals and small to mid-sized hospitals can join as part of a unified group. Groups consist of three or more hospitals with shared needs, typically organized by geography or health system. Participating hospitals identify other sites to form their group.



How It Works

Each hospital within the group enters into a separate service agreement with STeM. Agreements feature standardized terms, including specialties, scope of work, termination dates, reduced monthly minimum requirements, and a unified call schedule.



Program Benefits

By consolidating smaller hospitals into a larger functional network, participants share administrative costs, overhead, and minimums. The program fosters inter-hospital collaboration, enhancing patient access and alleviating financial pressures on hospitals with limited resources.
